

Wolfgang Jost, MD, PhD

Wolfgang Jost graduated from the Universities of Frankfurt/Main and Mainz, Germany. He completed his studies with a MD and a thesis at the University in Mainz. He had his specialist training and „habilitation“ (Privatdozent) at the University of Saarland, working as a consultant until 1995. In the same year, he was appointed chairman of the Department of Neurology at the Deutsche Klinik für Diagnostik, Wiesbaden. Since 2000 he is Professor of neurology. He was also Dean at the department for health sciences at the Hochschule Fresenius, Idstein. In 2015 he became chairman at the Parkinson-Hospital Ortenau, Wolfach. He is also consultant at the University of Freiburg since 2016.

Wolfgang Jost is a member of numerous scientific societies including the German Neurological Society and the Movement Disorder Society. In addition, Dr Jost serves on the editorial boards and/or as reviewer for a number of journals. For 2-years he was President of the German Parkinson Society, for 4-years Chair of the German Botulinumtoxin Society. His major research interests are Parkinson's disease, as well as dystonia and treatment with botulinum toxin. He has published over 250 scientific articles and several books, e.g. Atlas of Botulinum Toxin Injection.
